Foundational-Level Single Subject Credentials, Supplementary Authorizations, & Subject Matter Authorizations



Do you enjoy math or science? Would you like to teach in a middle school?

Several paths exist for earning a credential to teach middle school math or science. MSTI will help prepare you for the Foundational-Level Mathematics (FLM) or General Science (FLGS) credential through coursework and CSETs. Coursework that helps you earn a FL credential can also qualify you for a Supplementary Authorization (SA) or Subject Matter Authorization (SMA). - MSTI will reimburse CSET fees for FLM & FLGS credentials! This saves you \$\$\$!
- With an FLM/FLGS/ SMA, you can teach specified content to students in grades K-12. With a SA, you can teach math and science in grades K-9.

MATH PATHWAYS

- FLM: CSET 211 & 212 + CI 161/FLM
- Take 32 or more math units for a SMA
- SA: Math 75, 76, 77, plus at least 8 more units of Math courses
- SA: 10+ units of 100level Math (Math 100, 133, 134, and 138/139)

SCIENCE PATHWAYS

- FLGS: CSET 215 plus CI 161/FLGS
- Take 32 or more science units for SMA
- SA: BIOL10, NSCI 1A, NSCI 115, NSCI 116, PHYS 168S + 5 more units of BIOL, CHEM, EES, NSCI, or PHYS coursework



MSTI Support for Math/Science Credentials

MATH: Earn \$400 for the first pair of 130series math courses that you complete and \$400 more during the semester you apply for your SA or SMA.

science: Earn \$400 for taking PHYS 168S and NSCI 116 plus \$400 more during the semester you apply for your SA or SMA.
