Criteria:

- Taken at a regionally accredited college/university including community colleges for academic credit
- 3 semester units or 4 quarter units

- Passed with a grade of B or better, CR or P
- Be degree applicable

²A single English course may meet both the reading and writing requirements for the BSR. If the course is from a non-English Department, a verification letter from the registrar or the department chair that oversees the Mathematics or English department, as applicable, is required. The letter must state that a course passed by the applicant covered reading, writing, or mathematics. Such a letter could also attest that a single course sufficiently indicates proficiency in reading and writing combined.

³A course from a Non-Math Department may satisfy the math requirement for the BSR. A verification letter from the registrar or the department chair that oversees the Mathematics or English department, as applicable, is required. The letter must state that a course passed by the applicant covered reading, writing, or mathematics.
