Test Prep

Yes, CBEST and CSET admission requirements are currently suspended until August 31, 2021. However, you still need to pass them to complete the program (remember if you have earned a Liberal Studies Degree from 2016 on you do not need to take the CSETs because you are subject matter competent). We recommend that you still try to complete these exams as you apply. If that's not possible because of the testing date being canceled or difficulties scheduling a testing date due to COVID-19 then complete the special circumstances form with your application.
