Mild/Moderate

- Student needs are often characterized by underachievement, lack of social competence, impulsivity, distractibility, and inattentiveness
- Services are delivered primarily in the general education classroom
- Most students are earning a diploma

Moderate/Severe

- Student needs are often characterized as more significant (including adults with disabilities)
- This requires specialized support to address unique learning needs in general education, special classes, and the community
- Curriculum addresses academic, social, functional, or vocational needs
