RE: Commission Assurances for Fresno State Educator Preparation Programs

As the Acting Dean of the Kremen School of Education and Human Development and the Unit Head for Fresno State's Educator Preparation Programs, I assure that once a candidate is accepted and enrolls in one of our educator preparation program, Fresno State will offer the approved program, meeting the adopted standards, until the candidate:

- i. completes the program;
- ii. withdraws from the program;
- iii. is dropped from the program based on established criteria; or
- iv. is admitted to another approved program to complete the requirements, with minimal disruption, for the authorization.

In the event that a program closes for any reason, we have developed a teach out plan, which includes individual transition plans for each candidate as well as a plan for candidates and graduates to access their student records.
