<p>Program Precondition 4 (PPC) First Review: Please update first SMC option in the PK-3 Course Sequence to include <i>regionally</i> accredited institution of higher education.</p> <p>The process for verifying candidates with notification of their standing in relation to meeting the subject matter competence requirement is unclear. The Google form is a self-reported document. It is unclear how the program will be able to verify the candidate has met the requirement without collecting additional evidence.</p> <p>Provide evidence of the program's process for completing the assessment and providing candidates with notification of their standing in relation to meeting the subject matter competence requirement within 60 days of their admission to the program. This notification should include reference to how the candidate has completed the requirement or next steps to completion.</p>	<p>More information needed</p>
<p>Link(s) to Institution's Response to PPC 4 First Review:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The PK-3 Course Sequence has been updated to indicate the bachelor's degree must be from a regionally accredited institution of higher education. - The Google form that was shared will not be available to candidates. Instead, it will be used by the PK3 Admissions Analyst to track each applicants' qualifications, including how they are meeting subject matter competency. The Admissions Analyst will review each applicant's application materials and then complete the form based on what the candidate submitted. The checklist will NOT be completed by the applicants nor will it be shared with the applicants. It is a way for the Admissions Analyst to track the applicants. The results from the review of applications will populate a spreadsheet that will be used to track program applicants. The form also now includes that the Bachelor's degree must be from a regionally accredited institution of higher education. - Following the review of the applications, the Admissions Analyst will notify applicants of their standing in relation to meeting Subject Matter Competency. Because Subject Matter Competency is required for admission, we anticipate applicants will be informed that they met the requirement. In the event that a candidate has not met the requirement, they will be informed of what steps they need to take to meet the requirement.

Also, what is the role of the credential analyst in this process?</p> <p>The checklist appears to be for admission to the program rather than completing the program and applying for the credential – please clarify. Please provide reviewers information about what is reviewed (perhaps a screenshot from the TK-20 system?) that shows how candidate completion of requirements is verified at the end of the program.</p>	More information needed

<p>Link(s) to Institution's Response to PPC 6 First Review:</p> <p>The Fresno State PK3 Application Checklist now indicates the requirement that the BA or higher degree must be from an regionally accredited institution of higher education.</p> <p>Process for Verifying Completion of All Program Requirements:</p> <p>The PK3 Early Childhood Education Specialist Instruction program will ensure that only qualified candidates are recommended for the credential. Prior to admission each candidate will be required to sign and submit an Advising Roadmap form that shows the sequence of courses for their chosen pathway. The signed Course of Study form will be kept in the candidate's record and serves as the official Candidate Progress Monitoring document. Upon completion of the program and all requirements, the candidate will complete an application for the preliminary credential.</p> <p>Following receipt of the candidate's application, the University Credential Analyst will check the candidate's transcripts against the signed Advising Roadmap in the candidate's record to determine and document that the candidate has met the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - all courses have been completed with a 'C' grade or better; - minimum 3.0 Grade Point Average overall; - US Constitution requirement; - passing scores on the CBEST, CSET and RICA examinations; - valid Certificate of Clearance and CPR certificate for infants, children and adults; - passing scores on the teacher performance assessment

<p>After all requirements are met, the candidate will be recommended to CCTC for the preliminary credential.</p> <p>The Site Visitation Project (SVP) and the Teaching Sample Project (TSP) are the two components that make up the FAST. The SVP and the TSP links provided show screenshots from TK20, the data management system used by all Fresno State Teacher Education Programs. Scores for each rubric of the SVP and TSP are entered into TK20. Program personnel run reports in TK20 to track which candidates have passed the required elements.</p>
