<p><b>Pathology.</b> Supervised clinical practice in the diagnosis and treatment of communicative disorders; development of treatment programs, parent counseling, referrals; on-and off- campus clinical sites. CSDS 230 C1- 1st clinic, C2- 2nd clinic, C3- 3rd clinic</p>	90-132 hours	Earned over 2-3 semesters; there are also optional 1- unit Aphasia Clinics and LOUD Crowd Clinics for clients with Parkinson's that students can choose to take during their 2-5 semesters in the program.
<p><b>CSDS 250- Advanced Clinical Practice: Audiology.</b> Supervised clinical practice in diagnosis and management of hearing problems.</p>	20 hours	Earned over one semester
<p><b>CSDS 257- Student Teaching: Speech-Language Pathology.</b> Directed observation, participation, and clinical practice under supervision.</p>	100 hours approximate	Earned over one semester in K-12
<p><b>CSDS 267-Externship in Speech Language Pathology.</b> Supervised externship in diagnosis and management of communicative disorders.</p>	123-165 hours	Earned over one semester in a variety of medical facilities, private practice or other.
