

Application:

Single Subject University Coaches (Supervisors) are individuals who must possess:

- a clear credential and a minimum of three years experience teaching in the field they are supervising; or
- a clear administrative credential and a minimum of three years experience as an administrator; or
- have expertise in a teacher preparation program with a terminal degree, i.e. a doctorate in Education or Curriculum & Instruction.

Note: ALL Single Subject University Coaches (Supervisors) must have a minimum of master's degree in addition to the requirements listed above. With the exception of tenure/tenure-track faculty, all University Coaches (supervisors) are classified as temporary faculty by the university.

Single Subject University Coaches (Supervisors) are experts in the content area (Ag, Art, English, Industrial Technology, Math, Music, Physical Education, Science, Social Science, Foreign Language (Spanish and French) of the teacher credential candidate being supervised and should have recent professional and/or teaching experiences in a school setting where the curriculum aligns with California's adopted content standards and frameworks and the school reflects the diversity of California's student population.

The University Coach (Supervisor) should have current knowledge of supervision approaches such as cognitive coaching, adult learning theory, and current "content-specific" pedagogy and instructional practices.
