## What is a Teacher Residency?



- Year long student teaching placement on the District's Calendar
- Additional Supports and Professional Connections
  - Experienced, mentor teacher from start to finish
  - Experienced, university coach
  - District Managers & University Professors-in-Residence
- Co-teaching models are essential
- University-District Partnerships are vital
  - links theory to practice
  - Residents receive ongoing professional learning opportunities
  - District incentives such as stipends & technology

- Prepare teachers who are more diverse
- Prepare teachers for hardest to fill positions

<p>Incentives &amp; Support</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- \$12,000 stipend distributed over 18 months</li> <li>- Placed in a bilingual classroom with mentor teacher from Day 1</li> <li>- District-issued laptop/chromebook</li> <li>- Access to all MUSD professional learning</li> </ul>

- Special Education Residency
- Mild to Moderate or Moderate to Severe Education Specialist Credential
- $\frac{3}{4}$  Master's Degree coursework completed
- \$13,000 stipend to cover tuition
- 3 year commitment to teach at Clovis Unified
- Fall 2021 (courses only – Fresno State)
- Spring 2022, Fall 2022 (student teaching placement – Clovis Unified + coursework - Fresno State)

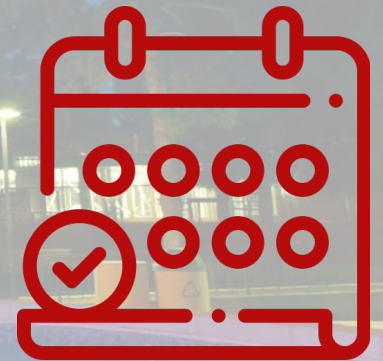
