

Fresno State Educator Preparation Teach-Out Plan

Fresno State does not anticipate closing any of its educator preparation programs. However, in the unforeseen event that a program is closed, the Unit has developed the following teach-out plan to ensure that enrolled candidates are able to complete their programs.

In the event that the unit determines a program should be closed, Unit leadership will communicate with all enrolled candidates to inform them of the closure and that they will have the opportunity to complete the program following the program timeline agreed upon at the time of admission. The appropriate program coordinator will work with each candidate to develop a transition plan to ensure they meet the program requirements.

To ensure this happens, the Unit will:

- Continue to offer courses in accordance with the program timeline for remaining candidates
- Continue to provide support to a program coordinator who will advise candidates as they complete program requirements
- Maintain relationships with local districts to ensure candidates have opportunities to complete their clinical practice

If a candidate wishes to leave Fresno State and complete their program elsewhere, Fresno State will provide them with their academic records and any additional materials necessary to make their transition as easy as possible. Candidates will not be penalized for making the decision to leave.
