The Board of Directors of the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP) met July 8-10, 2021, for the purpose of making accreditation decisions. At this meeting, the Board reviewed the Interim Report submitted by the Department of Counselor Education and Rehabilitation at California State University, Fresno. This report was required to more fully address policies and standards cited in the accreditation decision letter that was sent to the president's office and dated February 20, 2020.
