

Scholarship Application period October 1 – March 2**Who can apply?**

Everyone! All Fresno State students are eligible to apply for scholarships. The Kremen School of Education and Human Development has up to \$250,000 to award to students each year in addition to the outside entity scholarship opportunities offered.

How do I apply?

All scholarships are awarded through a [general campus-wide application](#) requesting the following information:

• Education Information**• Community Service or Volunteer Work Activities**

(Make sure you state your activities for the past 2-3 years. Including the name of organization and/or description of service performed, any leadership positions held in service, dates of service, and total number of volunteer hours.)

• Personal Statement


(A minimum of 300 words and includes such things as overall life experiences, accomplishments, recognitions, extracurricular activities, and any other information that you believe will be helpful in fully assessing your personal qualities, aspirations, and character.)

• Career Objective Statement

(Tell us how you will incorporate your education, experiences, interests, skills into the career or job position you are seeking after graduation.)

• Thanking Donors: Donors appreciate hearing from students and how their investment is helping you achieve your full potential.

Once your general application is complete, other recommended opportunities for various scholarships are made based on your completed application information. If applicable you will see a red **APPLY**. Additional questions and/or documents may be required.

When and how will I be notified if I receive a scholarship?

Fresno State scholarship awards are dedicated to students who are admitted and enrolled at Fresno State. If you are to receive a scholarship, a congratulatory email will be sent to your Fresno State email address. If more than one scholarship is awarded, you will receive a separate email for each award. You must follow the instructions in each email to ACCEPT the scholarship. **If you don't ACCEPT, you don't get the funds!**
