## **PROGRAM INFORMATION FOR ALL CANDIDATES**

- Candidates are encouraged to meet with an advisor or the Credential Program Coordinator when planning their
  professional preparation program. Candidates requesting to take more than 18 units need prior signed permission
  from the Credential Program Coordinator.
- 2. The professional coursework must be taken in the order of the phases shown, regardless of whether the candidate attends full-time or part-time. All courses in Phase 1 must be completed prior to beginning Phase 2, etc.
- 3. All credential coursework must be taken for a letter grade, except for courses which are only offered as Credit/No Credit grade.
- 4. An overall GPA of 3.00 must be maintained throughout the credential program with no grade lower than a 'C'. Candidates who earn a 'D', 'F', 'W', 'WU', 'NC', 'IC' or 'I' grade in any credential coursework must retake or complete those courses and pass with a 'C' grade or better. Retaking courses may result in additional semesters to complete the program.
- 5. Eligibility for final student teaching, EHD 170:
  - Submit the clinical practice application the semester prior and receive clearance to enroll.
  - b. Complete all previous phases with a 3.00 GPA and no 'D', 'F', 'W', 'WU', 'NC' 'IC' or 'I' grades
  - c. Possess a valid Certificate of Clearance and TB Risk Assessment

- 6. Eligibility for internship: (1) Phase 1 and Phase 2 coursework passed with a 3.0 GPA and no 'D', 'F', 'W', 'WU', 'NC' 'IC' or 'I' grades; (2) passed the Site Visitation Project of the <u>Fresno Assessment of Student Teachers</u>; (3) passed CBEST or equivalent; (4) passed all three Multiple Subject CSETs or a Liberal Studies degree; (5) passed a college level U.S. Constitution course with a 'C' grade or higher or passed an approved college level US Constitution exam. Interns must enroll in clinical practice every semester until the preliminary credential is granted. - 7. Apply for Preliminary Multiple Subject Credential upon successful completion of (1) all coursework with 3.0 GPA with all grades 'C' or higher; (2) passed the Site Visitation Project and Teaching Sample Project of the Fresno Assessment of Student Teachers; (3) passed CBEST or equivalent; (4) passed all three Multiple Subject CSETs or a Liberal Studies degree; (5) passed the RICA; (6) passed college level U.S. Constitution course with 'C' grade or higher or passing score on college level US Constitution exam; (7) completed individual development plan; (8) valid Certificate of Clearance; (9) TB Risk Assessment; (10) CPR certificate for infants, children and adults. - 8. To clear the preliminary credential, candidates must complete an Induction Program as advised by the employing district.

## **ADDITIONAL NOTES**

Preliminary Multiple Subject credential application eligibility:

- Complete all coursework with a 3.0 GPA [no D or F grades], within ten (10) years prior to applying for your preliminary credential.
- CSET scores are valid for a period of ten (10) years. Scores must be valid to apply for the intern or preliminary credential.
- Passing the RICA exam is required to apply for the preliminary credential.
- Possess a valid Certificate of Clearance and CPR certificate.
- Pass college-level U.S. Constitution course [with a C or higher] or approved Constitution exam
